LOCAL TRADESMAN'S DEATH –

Mr. Fred ROGERS passes away on Golden Anniversary....

We regret to announce the death which occurred shortly after six o'clock on Christmas morning, of Mr. **Frederick ROGERS**, head of the firm of ROGERS and Sons, tailors and outfitters of High-street. Singular to any, it was the anniversary of his Golden Wedding. Mr. ROGERS had not been in business in recent years owing to the loss of a leg which took place about ten years ago. He would have been 70 next month. He was one of the oldest of local tradesmen, having been in business in High-street for about 40 years, and was held in the greatest respect and esteem. Formerly he took a keen interest in sport, being captain of the old Vectis Cycling Club and chairman of the Football Club, Mr. ROGERS had only been ill about a couple of months and he will be much missed. He leaves two sons and three daughters (two of whom are married) with whom much sympathy is expressed.

The funeral is fixed for Saturday, a service being held at All Saints at 2.30 p.m.
