13 April 1848	24 January 1850	Lieutenant in Hastings, commanded by James William Morgan, flagship of Rear-Admiral Francis Augustus Collier, East Indies
12 August 1851	5 December 1851	Commander (2ic) in Waterloo, commanded by Montagu Stopford (fitting for the flagship of Vice-Admiral James Whitley Deans Dundas in the Mediterranean, until Britannia was selected instead)
5 December 1851	27 November 1852	Commander (2ic) in London, commanded by George Rodney Mundy, Sheerness
28 January 1853	19 January 1855	Commander in Espiegle, North America and West Indies
17 November 1860	15 July 1864	Captain in Immortalité (from commissioning at Portsmouth until paying off at Portsmouth), Mediterranean and (August 1861) North America and West Indies
16 May 1865	15 June 1867	Captain in Trafalgar, Coast Guard, Leith
15 June 1867	10 September 1867	Captain in Duncan, Coast Guard, Leith (Queensferry) (replacing Trafalgar)
10 September 1867	1872	Captain in Duke of Wellington, Portsmouth, training ship for seamen, then (20 December 1869) flagship of the port admiral, replacing Victory which became a tender
15 April 1876	August 1876	Commander-in-chief, Pacific (until he died) (flag in Repulse)
