We regret to state that our townsman, Councillor **MUNDELL**, has received sad intelligence of the death of his only son **George Bryan**, at the early age of 34. The deceased had been for some years resident in South Africa, but returned about a year ago to England to see his friends, and took a wife back to the Cape with him. In addition to a Government appointment, he had a farm at Glen Stuart, Water Klooff, Adelaide, South Africa, and had not long returned to settle down with his young wife when death overtook him. His father received the melancholy intelligence in a most kind and sympathetic letter from the clergyman of the parish in which he resided, and it must be a consolation to him to find that, although so far away from home his son had made many friends, and that his funeral was attended by a number of children, to whom it appears he was a teacher.
