OBITUARY

Many connected with yachting will hear with deep regret of the death of Mr. **George M. YATES**, captain of the yacht Nina, at the age of 37 years. The deceased was one of the best type of yachtsmen, was very much respected by all who came into contact with him, being a remarkable steady, quiet and persevering young man. He looked the picture of manly vigour and strength, but a violent chill, caught in the exercise of his calling, brought on an attack of pleurisy, to which he succumbed in a very few days. The deceased was interred in Ryde Cemetery on Wednesday, when the coffin was carried to the grave by the crew of the yacht Nina, by whom he was much beloved. The service at the grave was performed by the Rev. J. HOLDEN.
