### THE FUNERAL OF MISS E. G. PADMORE

The funeral of Miss **PADMORE** whose death occurred on Tuesday at her residence Ashley Lodge, after a long and painful illness, borne with Christian fortitude took place on Thursday morning last. The body was removed to the church early in the morning. The service which was choral and was taken by the vicar of Swanmore, took place at 11 o'clock, the interment being in the family grave at Ryde Cemetery whence the body was, conveyed on an open air car followed by four carriages and pairs. The principal mourners were the Misses PADMORE (sisters), Messrs. PADMORE (three brothers), Mrs. D. MARVIN (sister), Miss WATSON, Messrs. Douglas, John, and Eric MARVIN. A large number of friends were at the church including Dr. WADHAM, the medical attendant of deceased. Miss BARRY, Miss PILKINGTON, Miss JAMES, Mrs. TAYLOR, Mrs. WILSON, Mr. MELLISH, Mr. HOOPER, etc. The coffin was of polished oak with handsome brass ring handles and on the lid was a large brass Latin cross and plate engraved :

“Ellen Georgiana PADMORE,  
born, 21<sup>st</sup> May, 1859,  
died 2<sup>nd</sup> August, 1910.”

The whole of the arrangements were carried out by PURNELL and PURNELL. There were very beautiful floral tributes from “Auntie WATSON, Will, Emma, George, and Margaret,” “Ada, Douglas, John and Eric,” “All at Collingwood,” “To my loved and life-long friend,” “Mildred and Bob, the Misses BLUNT,” “Trixie,” Miss CRAMOR, Mr. and Mrs. C. MATTHEW, “Richard,

Ellen and Christine.” “Gussie, Willie and family,” “Miss PITMAN, Miss JAMES, and Miss ANSTEY, the Misses PILKINGTON, the Misses S. E. ATTRIDGE and E. C. SCHOLEFIELD, “Lillian ROOKE, Adela PHENE, and members of the Swanmore Boys Club,” “Fannie and Mary WEBB,” “Gertrude,” and “Marion DAWSON.”
