FUNERAL OF CAPT. SLOANE-STANLEY

The funeral of Captain SLOANE-STANLEY, RN., retired, who died suddenly on Friday of last week, took place at the cemetery on Thursday, the Rev. E. EWBANK officiating. The body was carried to the grave by six coastguards. A Union Jack, on which were the deceased's cocked hat and sword, was used for a pall.

There were a large number of lovely wreaths and crosses, amongst others from Mr. Frederick SLOANE-STANLEY, Eveline SLOANE-STANLEY, Amy SLOANE-STANLEY, Admiral Compton DOMVILLE, RN., Mrs and Miss Jasper LIVINGSTONE, and Mrs. R. C. WELESLEY.

The grave was lined with greenery. The polished oak coffin bore the inscription:-

"Cecil George SLOANE-STANLEY
Captain RN.
born April 23rd 1836
died January 30th 1891"

Messrs. LANGDON had charge of the arrangements.

NB: We have noted that although the surname was listed as hyphenated SLOANE-STANLEY on almost everything found, both the IW and General Registrars records show the surname as STANLEY.
