MR. F. A. CRANE –

Mr. **Frank Arthur CRANE**, aged 67, of 15 Victoria-street, collapsed and died at St. Thomas's-street on Sunday while returning from the beach. A post mortem examination this week revealed that death was caused by natural causes. Born in London, Mr. CRANE became a barrister's clerk in 1910 at the Temple in London. During the First World War he served with the Middlesex Regiment and was awarded the Distinguished Conduct Medal in 1918, being captured the same year. He was a keen cricketer, photographer and oil painter during his youth. Mr. CRANE retired in April this year, and moved to Ryde with his wife in early June. A service in the Ryde Cemetery Chapel today (Thursday) will precede interment. Messrs. C. LANGDON are making the arrangements.
