## NAVAL PENSIONERS SUDDEN DEATH

While in his garden at Alver Bank, Alexander-road, on Friday week, Mr. **Francis Robert JAMES** collapsed and died from a heart attack. He had not previously been ill, although he had suffered from rheumatism. A post mortem examination was made and the facts communicated to the Coroner who dispensed with an inquest.

Mr JAMES was a native of Portsmouth, but came to live here nearly 30 years ago, first at Marine Terrace, Castle-street, and then at High Park some three years since. He was 67 years of age. He spent most of his leisure in his garden. His wife predeceased him nearly two years ago.

The funeral took place on Tuesday at Holy Trinity Church and the interment was at the Cemetery. The Rev. S. A. MARSH officiated. The mourners were: Mr. Frank R. JAMES (son), Miss D. JAMES (daughter), Mr. and Mme Pierre VINARD (son-in-law and daughter), Mr. and Mrs. F. JAMES (brother-in-law and sister), Miss CASE, Mrs. POULTON, and Mr. and Mrs. E. LACEY. The grave was covered with beautiful flowers.
