The funeral took place at Ryde Cemetery on Saturday of Mrs. **Elsie Grace BUTT**, of 5 Station-street, Ryde, whose death occurred at the Royal I.W. County Hospital the previous Wednesday. She was fifty-one.

Mrs. BUTT, who was the youngest daughter of Mr. Samuel ADAMS, builder, and the late Mrs. ADAMS, of 22 Victoria-street, was born at Haylands and educated at Sandown Grammar School. As a young woman she was organist at Haylands Congregational Chapel for some years. She leaves a husband, son and two daughters, the elder of whom was married only about five weeks ago.

The Rev. H. McROW officiated At the service at the chapel and the interment, and the family mourners were Mr. F.L.BUTT (husband), Mr. F.D. BUTT (son), Mrs. H. WEISHAUP and Miss J. BUTT (daughters), Mr. S. ADAMS (father), Mr. F. ADAMS (brother), Mrs. B.E. BRADING (sister), Mrs. W. HANSON (sister), Mr. C. READ (cousin), Mrs. V. BRADING (niece).
