**MR. P. DUFFY**

Mr. **Patrick DUFFY** died at his home, 2, St. Mary's Passage, Ryde, on Saturday. He was 75.

Mr. DUFFY, who was a native of Ireland, had lived in that Island most of his life. He had been until two years ago employed by the Corporation. Failing health caused his retirement. His wife predeceased him nine years ago. He was a devoted member of St. Mary's Roman Catholic Church. Three daughters and one son survive him.

The funeral was at St. Mary's on Tuesday, being preceded by a requiem mass. Canon S. MONGAN officiated, assisted at the altar by Mr. E. DUFFY, the son. The mourners were Miss DUFFY, Mrs. O' MAHONEY and Mrs. TAYLOR (daughters), Mr. TAYLOR (son-in-law), and Miss Betty McCARTHY. Mr. B.F. HOLNESS (Borough Surveyor) and Mr. DIBBENS (foreman at the Town Yard) were also present.

A wreath was received from the Corporation. Interment followed at the Ryde Cemetery.
