OBITUARY

The death occurred on Friday week at Lovathome, Church-street, Swanmore, of Mr. **Ernest Alfred TURNER**, aged 67. He was chief goods clerk in the employ of the North Eastern Railway Co. at Victoria Station Nottingham, and came here to live following his retirement and marriage six years ago. He was formerly president of the Ashley Cricket Club.

The funeral was on Tuesday, the interment being preceded by a requiem Mass at St. Mary's (R.C) Church. The Very Rev. Provost S. MONGAN officiated. The mourners were Mrs. TURNER (widow), Messrs.
