#### **NAVAL PENSIONER'S DEATH**

The death occurred on Wednesday at the age of 71, of Mr. **Charles Harry ENGLAND**, of Glenross, High Park-road, a pensioner of the Royal Navy for 30 years. Mr. ENGLAND, a native of the town, joined the navy at an early age and served for nearly 24 years. His retirement was postponed owing to the first world war and he was eventually removed from the active list with the rank of chief torpedo coxswain. He then went to live in Cowes and was employed on the yachts of the Duke of Westminster, the Duke of Sutherland, and Lady HOUSTON. Later he was in the employ of Messrs. J. Samuel WHITE and Co., Ltd., as a rigger until 1944. His health and that of his wife was undermined by the Cowes blitz in 1942, in which their house was wrecked, and they made their new home here.

Sincere sympathy is felt with his wife in the parting after 41 years married life, and with his daughter and three sons. The funeral service takes place (to-day) Saturday at St. John's Church at 10.30.a.m.
