DEATH OF MR. L. BRIND

By the death on Friday week of Mr. **Louis BRIND**, the town lost one of its oldest

tradesmen. Mr. BRIND who was in his 85th year, commenced business as a grocer and provision merchant at 91 High-street over 60 years ago, and although in recent years it has been carried on by his son, he still took an active interest in it until laid aside two or three months ago. Mr. BRIND was well known and respected, his cheery ways and pleasant manner winning him many friends. His wife died some years ago.

The funeral Took place on Monday, a service being held at St. Mary's R.C. Church, conducted by Fr. HENNESSEY. The mourners were Messrs. C.F. and L.L. BRIND (sons), Mrs. OSBOURNE and Miss Kathleen BRIND (daughters), Mrs. Wilson CHALLON, Mrs. CONACHER, Mrs. J. CONACHER and Miss Hilda BRIND (nieces), and the Rev, Fr. Xavier DE BEAULANCOURT (Quarr Abbey) a number of friends and acquaintances were also present.

The interment was at Ryde Cemetery and there were numerous wreaths. Messrs. J. PERKIS and Son were the undertakers.
