DEATH OF MRS. PLETTS

It is with much regret we record the death of Mrs. **PLETTS** (the wife of our respected townsman Dr. J. Menham PLETTS of George-street), which occurred on the 10th inst., after a long and painful illness, at the comparatively early age of 34. If anything can lighten the force of the terrible blow which has fallen upon Dr. PLETTS, left as he is with a young family, it will be the assurance that the deepest sympathy is universally expressed for him.

The funeral took place on Thursday morning, the body being first taken to the Parish Church of All Saints, where the first portion of the office for the burial of the dead was read. The mournful *cortege* then proceeded to the Cemetery, the coffin being conveyed in an open car. The coffin, of polished oak, was almost hidden from view by a number of beautiful flowers. The service was conducted by the Rev. Alexander POOLE, vicar of All Saints, and the funeral arrangements were carried out by Mr. HANSFORD.
