#### **DEATH OF MRS. SHERWIN**

The townspeople heard with much regret of the death of a greatly respected trader who with her late husband carried on business in High-street for over 20 years. Mrs. **E. SHERWIN**, widow of Mr. Stephen SHERWIN of the Bon-Bon. She died on Wednesday after a few days illness as a result of influenza. On the previous Thursday she was about the shop as usual and her death was a great shock to her relatives and friends. The deceased was 57 years of age.

The funeral took place at the Cemetery on Saturday, amidst every sign of respect on the part of the relatives and friends who gathered at the graveside to pay the last tribute to one who was greatly esteemed throughout her life. The remains were laid beside those of her late husband and the Burial Service was carried out by the Rev. D.E. HUNTER, curate of All Saints. The mourners were Arthur and Jack (brothers), Mr. J.
