Miss **Amelia HALKETT**, of Pelham Lodge, left unsettled property in her own disposition of the gross value of £17,432.16s.1d., with net personalty £17,223.17s.10d. Miss HALKETT left £1000, free of duty, to the County Hospital, to endow an "Arthur HALKETT" bed or cot in the children's ward, in memory of her nephew; £20 to each servant in her service at her decease, of twelve months' service ; £2000 to her cousin, Col. Francis Charles HILL, who pre-deceased her ; £500 each to her cousins, Agnes Helen Napier TODD and Decima Mabel TODD ; £100 to Evelyn Arthur RICH, as executor, and the residue of her property equally between all the children of her cousins, Peter HILL and Francis Charles HILL.
