#### **DEATH OF ALD. MARVIN, J.P.**

We regret to have to record the death of Ald. **Edward MARVIN**, J.P. which took place at an early hour on Saturday morning. Although the deceased gentleman had been in failing health for some time past the end came quite unexpected he having been in the town only a day or so previously. The death of Mrs MARVIN some two years ago was a great and lasting grief to the deceased. He had served on the Old Commissioners, on the School Board and on the Magisterial Bench and in 1897 filled most efficiently the Mayoral Chair. In many other ways the late Mr MARVIN did much public service. Deceased was 75 years of age.

#### **THE FUNERAL**

.....took place this (Wednesday) afternoon at the Cemetery. The first part of the service was held at the Parish Church and was fully choral. The clergy present were The Revs W. M. CAMERON. Owen BULKELEY, C. BLAKE, A. JOHNSON and Dr SHONE, the latter being a very old friend of the deceased. In addition to the family mourners, the Mayor and members of the Corporation and many of the leading townsmen attended the obsequies. The floral tributes were very beautiful.
