The funeral took place on Saturday, following his death the previous Tuesday, of Mr. **Charles George MARTIN** of 63 George Street, Ryde. A native of Portsmouth, Mr. MARTIN had lived most of his life on the Island, first at Newport, and for the last 27 years at Ryde. He was aged 64.

He joined the Royal Navy as a youth, and served for 18 years. During the first world war he saw action in the Battle of Jutland, and during the recent war he was employed with the Naval personnel at Puckpool. Mr. MARTIN was a member of the British Legion, and was a keen follower of football. He leaves a widow, one son, two brothers and four sisters, his mother having predeceased him by only two years.

The funeral service, which was at Holy Trinity Church, was conducted by the Vicar, the Rev. D. FORD, and was followed by interment at Ryde Cemetery. The family mourners were: Mrs. MARTIN (widow), Mr. J. MARTIN, (son) and Mr W. MARTIN (brother). Other members of the family were unable to be present through illness.
