DEATH OF AN OLD PRACTITIONER

On Wednesday morning last at his residence, 3, Lind Terrace, Dr. BEATON passed away. He was an old and respected inhabitant of Ryde, although he did not take an active part in affairs connected with the town. He was for a considerable period Medical officer for the East Medina Lodge of Oddfellows, who a few years back presented him with a testimonial to show their appreciation for his long and willing services. He was also, for a good number of years Medical Officer for the Ryde District. Through his old and venerable age he was compelled some years ago to give up his occupation. A widow and daughter are left to mourn their loss.

The funeral took place on Monday afternoon at the Cemetery. There was a large attendance of medical gentlemen. The service was performed by the Rev. W. H. REDKNAP.
