MAGISTRATE'S DEATH

Mrs. Winifred Mary BROWNE, J.P., aged 71, of 136 Marlborough-road, died suddenly at her home on Wednesday. Born at Fishbourne, Mrs. BROWNE was the daughter of Colonel J. E. RHODES, commander of the I.W. Rifles during the 1914-18 war, and Mrs. RHODES. She lived all her life in the borough except for a few years spent in France after that war.
