PAINFUL SUDDEN DEATH AT RYDE TOWN HALL

Mrs. **Elizabeth JONES**, of Hill-street, died with tragic suddenness at the Town Hall, Ryde, on Thursday evening. She had been to the Industrial Exhibition with her daughter, and was leaving at about ten minutes past 9 o'clock. When descending the first flight of steps she fell backwards and died in a very few minutes. Mr. Supt. HINKS was near and he stopped the people from entering or leaving by the principal entrance, and despatched a messenger for a doctor. It was, however, very apparent that the case was hopeless, and on arrival of Dr. PRESTON in a few minutes, life had departed. Deceased, who leaves several children, was 47 years of age. She had not been ill or made any complaints. The body was removed in an ambulance carriage to the mortuary, where it awaits an inquest.
