

**MRS. I. B. BALLANTYNE –**

We regret to report the death of Mrs. **Ivy Bessie BALLANTYNE**, eldest daughter of Mr. Alfred GISSING, of the Solent Hotel, Monkton-street, Ryde, which took place at Winchester Hospital on Friday at the early age of 31. Deceased will be remembered in Seaview as the widow of Mr. Horace HALLETT, a pilot, of “Ortana”, Ryde-road, her first husband, who died in 1930. She had only re-married a twelve-month ago and sympathy will be expressed with the husband in his loss. The death occurred very suddenly, deceased being taken ill only on Wednesday last. Mrs. BALLANTYNE had lived in the district for ten years before her second marriage, when she took over the Exchange Hotel, Winchester. Two children are left by the first husband.

The remains were brought to Ryde for burial, the Rev. S. A. MARSH (Vicar) conducting the funeral service at Holy Trinity Church on Monday afternoon, the interment being at the Ryde Cemetery. The mourners were Mr. W. L. BALLANTYNE (husband), Mr. GISSING (father), Mrs. W. SIVELL (sister), Miss D. GISSING (sister), Mrs BENNETT and Mrs. CHURCHER (aunts).

Deceased was buried in the same grave as her first husband.
