FUNERAL OF MRS. BLAKE

The funeral of the late Mrs. **BLAKE**, of Nelson-street, took place at the Cemetery on Thursday, the Rev. C. Rhodes HALL officiating. The body was enclosed in a polished oak coffin with raised lid and heavy brass mountings. The inscription was: Louisa BLAKE, died 28th October 1901, in her 78th year.
