**DEATH OF MISS M. NEIL**

Within four days of the death of Miss E. R. MASKELYNE, of Holly Tree, Marlborough Road, her cook, Miss **M. NEIL**, who had been in her service for 35 years, died at the same address on Tuesday. She had been seriously ill for about two months. Miss NEIL was a member of St. John's branch of the Conservative Association. She was formerly a regular worshipper at St. John's Church where the Vicar (the Rev. A. J. PEARMAN), officiated at the funeral service yesterday afternoon.
