OBITUARY  
**MRS. C. S. SCOVELL**

The death occurred at St. Mary's Hospital on Friday, of Mrs. **Catherine Sutherland SCOVELL**, formerly of Medina Lodge, Melville Street, Ryde.

Mrs. SCOVELL, who was 88, was a native of Wick, Caithness, Scotland, but had spent most of her life in the Island. She was the widow of Mr. Robert SCOVELL, former member of a tent-making firm in Castle Street, Ryde, who died in 1935. She lost her only son during the first world war and her daughter died when only 12 years old.

She was a member of Holy Trinity Mothers' Union and the Ryde Darby and Joan Club.

The funeral service took place at Holy Trinity Church on Monday, the Vicar, (the Rev. D. FORD) officiating. Family mourners were Mr. and Mrs. A. SCOVELL (nephew and niece), Mr. and Mrs. A. REEVES (representing Mr. and Mrs. D. ROBERTSON of Wick, nephew and niece) and Mrs. W. BRADING. Floral tributes included those from the Darby and Joan Club and Holy Trinity Mothers' Union. Interment took place in her husband's grave at Ryde Cemetery.
