in his presence at his request and in the presence of each other (all present at the
same time) hereunto subscribed our names as witnesses – G. R. Dodd New Broad St
London Solr. – Edmd. Wellarriott Ryde Isle of Wight Surgeon.
Proved at London 13 th April 1847 before the Worshipful William Robinson of Laws and Surrogate by the oath of Fanny Dodd Widow the Relict the sole Executor to whom Admon was granted having been first sworn duty to administer.
