MR. HENRY SPANNER

The death took place in London on Monday of Mr. **Henry SPANNER**, for very many years a well-known and greatly respected tradesman of the town, at the age of 70. The funeral took place at the Ryde Cemetery yesterday afternoon, the body being first taken to Holy Trinity Church, of which deceased was once a churchwarden. The Rev. W. M CAMERON officiated. The mourners were Mrs. SPANNER (widow), Mrs. PRATT and Miss A. SPANNER (daughters), Mr. and Mrs. CLARKE, Major WALKER, and Mr. A. HILL. There were flowers from the widow, Mrs. PRATT, Harry and Mrs. KINNAIRD, the Rev. A. J. WADE, Mr. and Mrs. A. HILL, Madeline, Mr. and Mrs. HAYDON, and others.
