RYDE GARAGE OWNER DIES IN LONDON –

The death occurred yesterday at the Atkinson Moreley's Hospital, Wimbledon, of a well-known Ryde resident, Mr. **Albert Benjamin MUSKETT**.

A native of Norwich, Mr. MUSKETT had lived in the Island for many years and carried on a garage and motor engineer's business at his home address, 1 Albert-street.

He collapsed in the street on Thursday and was taken to the I.W. County Hospital, late being transferred to Wimbledon for a brain operation. An inquest is to take place there today.

A widower, who married a second time, Mr. MUSKETT leaves a widow, two sons, two daughters, and three step-daughters. He was 57.

The funeral service, prior to interment at Ryde Cemetery, will take place on Tuesday at Holy Trinity Church, Ryde.
