DEATH AND FUNERAL OF MRS. SIVELL

The funeral took place on Friday of Mrs. **Jane SIVELL** who passed peacefully away at 3 Nelson-place in her 91st year. Death resulted from a seizure she had three weeks previously.

She was greatly repected and had lived in the same house for 50 or 60 years, being the widow of Mr. Thos. SIVELL a well-known Trinity House pilot as was also her late son Fred SIVELL. Her surviving son, Mr. Tom SIVELL, is in Johannesburg, S. Africa, and a prominent Freemason. There are likewise four daughters left to mourn her loss.
