THE LATE MR. GEORGE LEWIS LEEDS

Our obituary records the death of Mr. George Lewis LEEDS, of Kent Lodge, Ryde, who died some what suddenly on Friday last, from influenza. The deceased gentleman was the youngest son of the late Sir Joseph LEEDS, Bart., and a nephew of the late Major A. F. LEEDS, who was so much esteemed in Ryde.

The funeral of Mr. LEEDS took place on Tuesday last. The polished oak coffin, with brass furniture, bore the inscription, "George Lewis LEEDS. Born 1845. Died January 12th, 1900." The mourners were Mr. Max LEEDS (son), Colonel CRADOCK, Mr. H. CRADOCK, Captain CODINGTON, Mr. Edgar RATCLIFFE, and the Household Servants. Beautiful wreaths were sent from his wife, his children, Col., Mrs. CRADOCK and Mr. H. CRADOCK, Mrs. A. F. LEEDS, and Mr. and Mrs. Brooke LEEDS, Mrs. Mashiter HELENE, the Servants of Kent Lodge, Admiral and Mrs. BONHAM, Lady LEEDS and Sir Edward LEEDS, Sir Francis and Lady CUNNINGHAME, Colonel and Mrs. Howard BROOKE, Mr. and Mrs. W. Player BRIGSTOCKE, Mr. and Mrs. W. R. RATCLIFFE, Mrs. RAWSEN, and Mrs. Henry LEEDS. The service at the grave was read by the Vicar, (the Rev. J. SHEARME). Messrs. HANSFORD were the undertakers.
