DEATH OF MRS. E. SHERLOCK –

The death occurred on Friday week, within a few weeks of her 82nd birthday, of Mrs. **Eliza Sherlock** at the home of her daughter (Mrs E. SLOACOMBE) after a short illness. Mrs. SHERLOCK was a lifelong resident of Ryde, one of the early members of the Darby and Joan Club, an old member of All Saints' Mothers' Union and a regular worshipper at All Saints' Church. The funeral took place at All Saints' Church on Tuesday, the Vicar (the Rev. A. CORY, R.D.) officiating, and Mr. W. REED (organist) accompanied the hymns. The mourners included Mr. G.
