## DEATH OF MR. VIVIAN A. WEBBER

The death is announced, at Dover, of Mr. Vivian Arthur WEBBER, who for many years resided at Ryde. The deceased was at one time an officer in the 67<sup>th</sup> Foot. Locally he will be best remembered for his generous patronage of art, and for his gifts of very handsome paintings, executed by the late Mr. FOWLES, of Ryde, to the towns of Newport, Ryde, Shanklin, Ventnor, Portsmouth, and Southampton. These gifts were most disinterested in their character, as Mr. WEBBER had no connection with the towns to which the pictures were presented. On several occasions he lectured upon art in Newport, Ryde and other towns. He was a great enthusiast upon all matters connected with painting and sculpture, a man of wide reading, considerable classical attainments, and great critical acumen, and a chess-player of more than average skill. The deceased gentleman frequently contributed to the London and provincial press. He was a Knight of the Legion of Honour.
