### DEATH OF MR. J. N. HATHWAY

We regret to record the death on Monday, at the age of 70, of Mr. **J. N. HATHWAY**, of Binstead, of which place he had long been a most respected resident. For some years he was a Guardian of the Poor for the parish and also its churchwarden. The funeral took place yesterday afternoon at Ryde Cemetery. The first part of the service was held at Binstead Church by the Rev. Canon PHILLIPS in the presence of a large congregation. The hymns "Lead kindly Light," and "Peace, perfect peace," were sung. Mr. O.T. FEBEN presided at the organ. The body was enclosed in a polished elm coffin. The mourners were Mrs. HATHWAY, Mr. A. A. BARNES, Mrs. PHILLIPS, Nurse HICKS, Mr. and Mrs. HAYLES and the servants. In the remainder of the service at the Cemetery the Rev. J. SHEARME (vicar of Ryde) assisted.

Carriages were sent by Miss BRIGSTOCKE, Mr. OGLANDER, J.P., Mrs. Mark HUNTER, Major Lowther CROFTON, Mrs TATTNALL, Mr Pakenham MAHON, and Lieut. GARTSIDE-TIPPING, R.N. There was also a large attendance at the Cemetery, including Mr. OGLANDER, Col. CAREY, Mr. Percy THELLUSSON, and the Hon. Mr. and Mrs. VEREKER. About 70 floral tributes were sent.

Messrs. Purnell were the undertakers.
