DEATH AND FUNERAL OF MRS. BOGER

With much regret we have to record the death of Mrs. **BOGER**, which occurred suddenly on Saturday last while on a visit to London. The body was conveyed home to Elvington House, on Tuesday last, and the funeral took place on Wednesday morning in Ryde Cemetery, deceased being

buried in the family grave with her husband, who predeceased her some fourteen or fifteen years. The principal mourners were deceased's three sons. General and Mrs. FETHERSTONHAUGH, Mrs. EDDIS and others also attended, the service being held in the Church at the Cemetery. There were an unusually large number of most beautiful floral tributes. The outer casket was of dull polished oak with panelled sides and raised lid with handsome brass handles and fittings. The inscription on the brass plate was :-

HELEN MARGARET BOGER

Entered into rest,
June 8th, 1912.

The grave was lined with evergreens and flowers. The whole of the arrangements both in London and at Ryde were entrusted to and carried out by Messrs. Purnell and Purnell.
