### DEATH OF MRS. HEWARD

The death took place on Tuesday of Mrs. **Sarah HEWARD**, of 9 St. John's-road. The deceased, who was the widow of Mr. W. HEWARD, a former fishmonger in business in the High-street, was 80 years of age. The funeral took place on Thursday, the first part of the service being held at the Parish Church.
