He was a native of Arreton and well-known in the Island as a builder, having commenced business in Ryde about the year 1847, and taken part in many important works. He was a member of the old body of Ryde Commissioners and when the town was incorporated he became a member of the first

council, which office he filled for several terms. There is now only one of the original members of the Ryde Town Council living, Mr. Thomas DASHWOOD, J.P., who was the first Mayor in 1868.
