NONAGENARIAN'S DEATH –

Mrs. **Amelia Augusta GAWN**, widow of Mr. Edward GAWN, died at Milton House, Nelson-street, on Sunday aged 91. She fractured her leg 10 years ago and had since been bedridden. Her husband for several years conducted a carrier's business in the town, which was subsequently merged with CURTISS and Sons. Mrs. GAWN was a native of Chislehurst, but had lived in Ryde during most of her life. The funeral service was held in the Cemetery on Tuesday, Canon MOXON officiating. Those present were Mr. E.
