### **DEATH OF MR. G. H. TURNER**

The death occurred on Friday week of Mr. **George Henry TURNER**, at Hortons, St. John's Wood-road. Mr. TURNER was a native of Cuckfield, Sussex, and settled here 28 years ago. He had been an invalid all his life, and for the last 10 years was blind, but, despite his infirmities, he took a great interest in local affairs, especially horticulture. He was seriously ill for 10 days before his death.

The funeral service was at St. Mary's R.C. Church on Tuesday, when Father MCDERMOTT, ROE (assistant priest) officiated. The mourners were Mrs. L. G. TURNER (widow), Mr. L. S. TURNER (brother), and the Misses A. I. and O. C. TURNER (sisters). The interment took place at Binstead Cemetery.
