

GEORGE PEABODY RUSSELL

Born 12 May 1834 (or 1835), in New Rowley near Georgetown, Mass. USA, son of Judith Dodge Peabody (born 5 April 1799) and lawyer Jeremiah Russell (married September 1831), he was named after his uncle George Peabody, Stockbroker. Jeremiah died 2 May 1860. Judith remarried Robert Shillaber Daniels (born 1791).

George received his B.A. in 1856 at Harvard. He practised law with his father in Haverhill, Mass. USA.

George Peabody Russell married Lucy Isabella Campbell 5 July 1860, daughter of Rev George W Campbell, of Bradford, Mass. USA. He moved to Monksfield, Binstead, Isle of Wight. On his mother's death 20 April 1879, age 80, he inherited a considerable family fund she held in trust from her deceased brother George Peabody.

Lucy Isabella Campbell Russell, age 45, died at Monksfield, Binstead, Isle of Wight in October 1887 and was buried in Binstead Cemetery on 31 October 1887 (plot unknown).

George died 23 June 1909 at 50 Brook Street, Mayfair, London and was buried in a vault under a brick mausoleum in Binstead Cemetery on 26 June 1909, Row A – B Plots 19-23. His obituary appeared in the London Times on 7 July 1909. He purchased the plot on 25 August 1879.
