FUNERAL OF MRS. R. W. TRAVES

The funeral of Mrs. **Thurza Mildred TRAVES**, of 8 King's-road, Binstead, the announcement of whose death, at the age of 42, was reported in our last edition took place on Wednesday.

The Rev. A. TRIGGS officiated at the first part of the service which was held at the house. The interment was at Binstead Cemetery, and the personal mourners were Mr. R. W. TRAVES, (husband), Mr. Ronald TRAVES (son), Mrs. E. ROLF (sister), Mr. L. POTTS (step-brother), Nurse TURTLE (cousin), Mrs. WOLF (aunt), Mr. A. TRAVES (brother-in-law), and Mr. H. JAMES.

There were over 30 choice floral tributes, including tokens from the Girl Guides and Miss N. M. A. SIMMONDS and the Binstead School.
