THE FUNERAL –

....of Mrs. **Eliza Benick COOPER**, of Evelyn Villa, Trinity-street, took place on Saturday afternoon. Deceased, who died the previous Monday at the age of 85, was a native of the town, and the eldest grand-daughter of the late James PURNELL, formerly of Cross-street. Mr. and Mrs. COOPER had been married for 63 years and brought up a family of 13 children. Much sympathy is felt for the aged widower and the other members of the family. The first part of the service was held at Holy Trinity Church, the Rev. Noel H. STUBBS officiating, and the interment was at the Cemetery, where the grave was covered with choice flowers. The chief mourners were Mr. Charles COOPER (husband), Messrs.
