FUNERAL OF FORMER COUNCIL EMPLOYEE

The funeral took place on Saturday of Mr. **William KARLEY**, of 3 Stainer's-terrace, Weeks-road, who died on the previous Tuesday at the age of 72. Mr. KARLEY was for many years an employee of the Corporation. and was a conscientious workman. At the funeral his colleagues were represented by Messrs. A. J. WHEELER (general foreman), J. JOLLIFFE, F. RUSSELL, R. FURMAGE, and C. LEAL. The interment was preceded by a short service at Parish Church, conducted by the Rev. H. COLLIER.
