A LOCAL WILL

Mr. **Robert George Sibley**, of Rose Bank, Binstead, who died on September 13th last, left estate of the gross value of £6,791 13s 7d, of which the nett personalty has been sworn at £2,224 17s 9d. Probate of his will, dated January 21st, 1895, with a codicil of August 13th 1897, has been granted to his son, Mr. Wm. Sibley, Company Director, of 18, Grafton-street, Dublin, and Mr Thomas Owden Spencer, grocer, of Treverward, Nightingale-road, Guildford, to the last names of whom he bequeathed £50 for his services.

The testator left his household and personal effects and all of his property in trust for his wife for life, and on her decease made numerous bequests of shares and of real estate and mortgages to his several children and grandchildren, and left £200 to his gardener, William Taylor, if in his service at his decease. Subject to these bequest he left the residue of his property to his sons William and George in equal shares.
