The testator bequeaths £7000 to his niece, Mary ADAM; an annuity to his brother, Francis; £4,000 between the daughters of his said brother; £6,000 Brazilian stock to his sister, Mrs Henrietta DICKSON CARTER, and his nieces Augusta KING, Ellen BURTON, and Maud RAVENHILL; and legacies to his executors and servants. The residue of his real and personal estate he gives to his niece Florence DICKSON.
