OBITUARY-

The death took place on Sunday of Mrs. **Flora Emily Priscilla BOURNE**, wife of Mr. G.BOURNE, of 41 St John's-road. Deceased was a native of Wootton, and was 75 years of age. During her husband's service in the Army she accompanied him to India, but for the last 38 of their 53 years of married life they had lived in the borough. The funeral took place at the Parish Church on Wednesday. The chief mourners were Mr. G.BOURNE (husband), Mr. G.BOURNE (son), Mrs. JACOBS and Mrs. WATTON (daughters), Mr. PECKHAM (son-in-law), Mrs. SULLIVAN (sister), Mrs. AVARD (sister-in-law), and Miss AYLES and Mrs. MALMO (nieces).
