It is with much regret that we announce the death of Mrs. **Martha Alma SIBLEY** (77) of 9 Daniel-street, which occurred on Thursday morning. Deceased, who was the wife of Mr. R. J. SIBLEY, the oldest employee of the Ryde Gaslight Company, had been in poor health for some years, but her last illness, which she bore with great patience, was of a month's duration. A native of Arundel, she had lived in Ryde all her married life, a period of 44 years.
