THE REV. PHILIP HEWETT

It is with much regret that we have this week to record the death of the Rev. **Philip HEWETT**, M.A., Rector of Binstead, which took place on the 15th instant, after a short illness. The late Rector had reached the advanced age of 80 years and upwards, having ministered at Binstead for no less a period of 46 years, and being all but one the senior Incumbent in the Island. By his quiet devotion to his work through so long a pastorate, by his genial and courteous manner, and generally by his simplicity and straight forwardness of character, he amply justified the estimation to which he was held, and, among Clergy, Parishioners, and friends, very large is the number, who will be led deeply to sympathize with his family in the loss they have sustained.
