DEATH OF MR. M. H. BISHOP

The death occurred suddenly at the Royal I.W. County Hospital on Tuesday, of Mr. **Malcolm Henry BISHOP**, aged 57, of 105 High-street. Mr. BISHOP was born here and when only 15 years old joined the I.W. Rifles, serving at Gallipoli. Subsequently he fought with the Hampshire Regiment in France and was invalided from the Army with a severe leg wound.
