The death occurred suddenly at the I.W. County Hospital on Friday week of Mrs. **Ada Emily WICKETT**, aged 56, of 51 Arthur-street. A native of Ryde, Mrs. WICKETT was a committee member of the Haylands Horticultural Society, of which her husband Mr. R. A. WICKETT is president and one of the society's oldest members. Mr. WICKETT has been proprietor of Pound Mead Nurseries, Upton-road, for nearly 30 years. Mrs. WICKETT was a member of the Haylands Women's Institute for many years and was also a member of the Parish Church. The funeral took place at the Parish Church on Wednesday, the Vicar (the Rev. R.
