FUNERAL OF THE HON. GEORGE LIDDELL

The remains of the Hon. **George LIDDELL**, of Somerville, St. John's, who died on Thursday last, in his 80th year, were interred in Ryde Cemetery on Tuesday afternoon. The massive oak coffin was conveyed from the residence of the deceased upon a Wellington funeral car, drawn by four horses. There were four mourning coaches, and several private carriages, amongst the mourners being Lord RAVENHURST, and other distinguished members of the family.

The funeral ceremony was empressively performed by the Rev. H. EWBANK, and Mr. SIMMONDS, of High-street, was the undertaker. The coffin was covered with spendid wreaths of choice flowers.

The deceased gentleman was the eldest surviving son of the first Lord RAVENSWORTH, and was brother of the Hon. and Rev. R. LIDDELL, Col the Hon George Augustus LIDDELL, Deputy Keeper of Windsor Great Park, the Dowager Duchess of HARDWICk, and Lady BLOOMFIELD. He married, in May 1842, Louisa, second daughter of General Hon. Robert MEADE, which lady died in March 1873.

By his decease the Earl of RAVENSWORTH, the Marquis of NORMANDY, Lady Florentia HUGHES, Hon Mrs. VILLIERS, the Earl of HARDWICKE, Lady Elizabeth WILLIAMSON, and other families of rank are placed in mourning.
